- Blake Prewitt, NCRESA Superintendent, and Ben Gilpin, NPS Superintendent, were present and gave a presentation discussing education performance in the County. They provided statistic information and discussed areas they felt could be enhanced.
- Julie Burrell, Senior Economic Development Director, Newaygo County, was present and gave updates on various programs and events. She discussed the Revitalization and Placemaking (RAP) Program that will provide access to gap financing for public space and place-based infrastructure. Burrell stated that a presentation on Newaygo County Economic Outlook would be presented on January 28<sup>th</sup>.
- Kelly Rider, Executive Director of River Country Chamber of Commerce, was present and gave updates on: Lunch and Learn Sessions being offered by the Chamber, Leadership Program being offered by the Chamber, the upcoming Newaygo Christmas Walk, and a Visioning Session for the Chamber.
